This year, New Life Center continued efforts toward becoming community leaders for quality, client-centered domestic violence services. Our team has implemented many changes to ensure every client has a positive and personalized healing experience. Each program has experienced growth, whether in the capacity of additional staff positions, more survivors served, or more services offered. This growth allows New Life Center, and most-importantly our clients, to thrive. New Life Center is rolling out 2019 as a dual service provider for sexual assault and domestic violence survivors.

Sexual assault is a prevalent issue in society and in our community. In order to fully understand the gap in services New Life Center can fill, we will be conducting a needs assessment, both internally and externally. This assessment will consist of discussions with New Life Center staff, board members, community partners, donors, volunteers, law enforcement, city officials, residents and survivors. I am very proud of New Life Center and excited to lead us into this new phase of life. We have a powerful history of being pioneers in the field of domestic violence. We plan to provide the same support to survivors of sexual assault. New life Center is being launched into an exciting future with goals to grow and thrive. 2018 was an amazing year for New Life Center and all of our programs across the board. The Children's Program has seen substantial growth with the institution of individualized case plans for all children and youth, family-focused safety planning, and educational curriculum-based support groups for all ages. Through this added programming, we have seen increased resilience and confidence in the children served. Upon program completion, 61% of guardians reported a decrease in post-traumatic stress levels for their children. The Residential and Outreach Programs have also seen improved programmatic success. A Housing Specialist position was added that allows for improved responsiveness to the housing-related needs of our clients. Along with this role, New Life Center is now able to provide monetary support for clients to secure safe housing through our 'housing barrier relocation fund.' Based on need, the funding can support various fees such as utility bills, first month's rent, or housing deposits. Likewise, we have obtained funding that assists clients in purchasing state identification cards or birth certificates for themselves and their children. Often, we see that the abusive partner destroys these documents to control their partner; resulting in decreased access to employment and housing opportunities. By supporting clients in this way, NLC can further our advocacy as clients regain their own stability and independence. All of this growth would not be possible without the ongoing support of our community. I am truly thankful for the staff, donors, and volunteers who make the New Life Center mission possible.

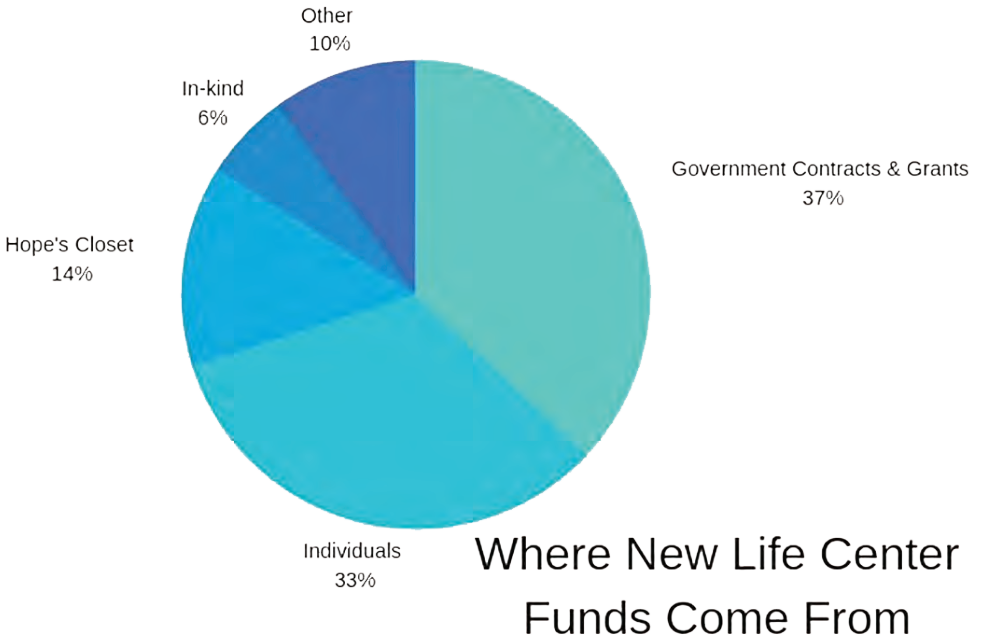

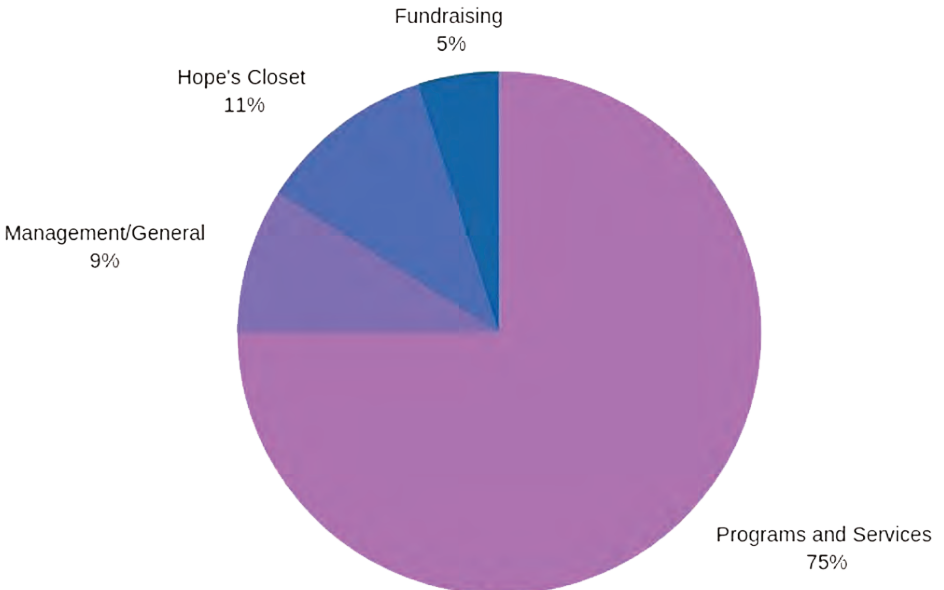

Fiscal Year 2018 Finances



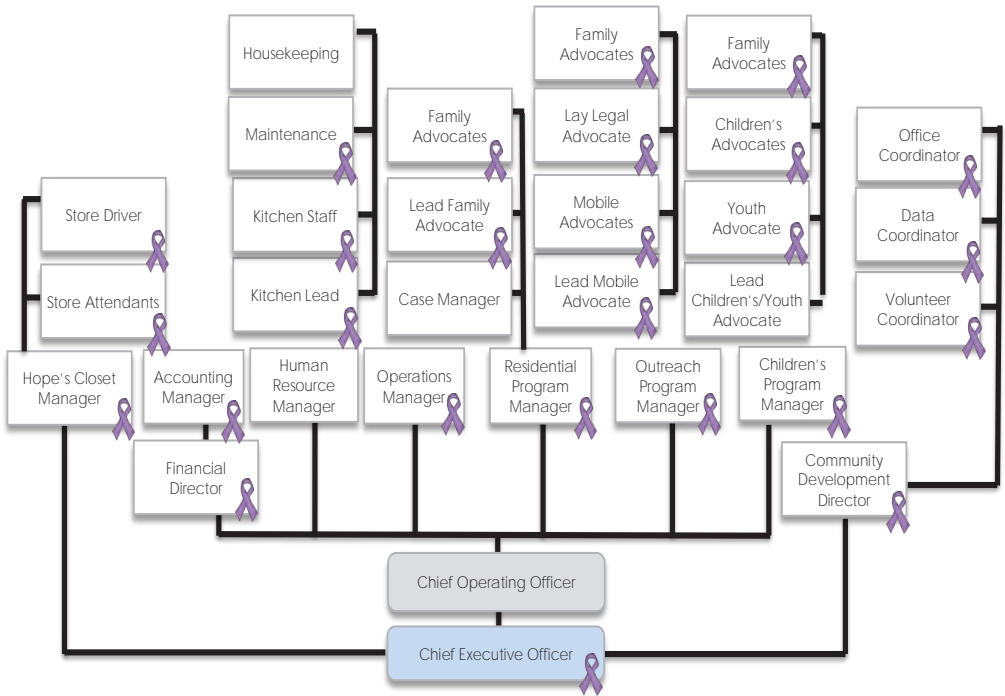
Where New Life Center Funds Go

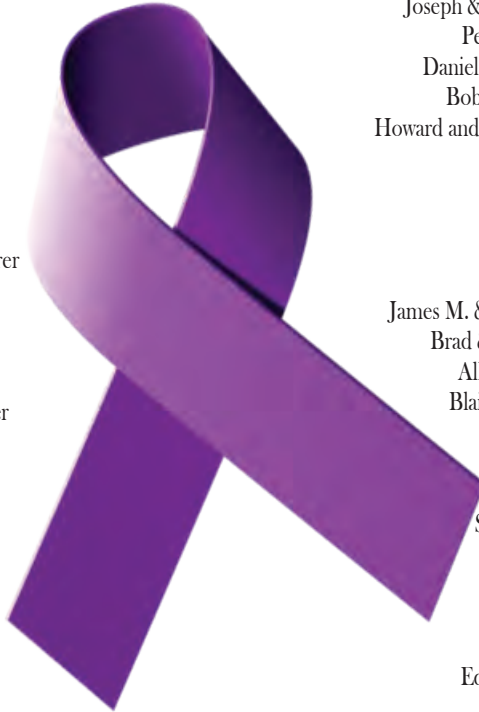
