# THANK YOU!

As I reflect back on 2019, I am grateful to our staff, Board of Directors, volunteers and donors who allowed New Life Center to grow and thrive so that the survivors we serve can do the same. With the addition of services to help survivors of sexual assault, we modified our mission statement at New Life Center to better reflect the scope of our services that help individuals heal from the trauma of domestic and sexual violence. Our new mission statement is: Helping to eliminate domestic and sexual violence through support services, education, and expertise.

In 2018, there were 3,201 reported rapes in Arizona alone, according to an annual report compiled by the Arizona Department of Public Safety. Of this number, more than 2,000 rapes were reported in Maricopa County. With the recent addition of services to support victims of sexual assault, New Life Center is poised to have a greater impact throughout our community than ever before.

It is because of our expertise and commitment to creating safer Arizona that New Life Center was awarded a federal grant in 2019 to Building Capacity within New Life Center to Support Victims of Human Trafficking. Partnering with Dr. Dominique Roe-Sepowitz, director of Arizona State University's Office of Sex Trafficking Intervention Research, the three-year program will cover research, and direct service programming. Our end goal is to increase the awareness, availability and accessibility of high-quality comprehensive services for victims.

The introduction of this program and all services at NLC is central to our commitment to increase community awareness and create the most effective, trauma-informed practices for helping survivors heal from the trauma of violence and abuse. Other key partnerships that have aided in our growth include the Governor's Office of Youth, Faith and Family, Maricopa County Attorney's Office, local Family Advocacy Center's, regional and local police departments and other community based nonprofits.

As we embark on new and better ways to serve survivors of domestic and sexual violence, we remain committed to removing all barriers that could impede a survivor's chance of healing and living life on their own terms.



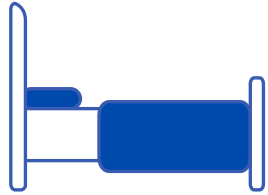

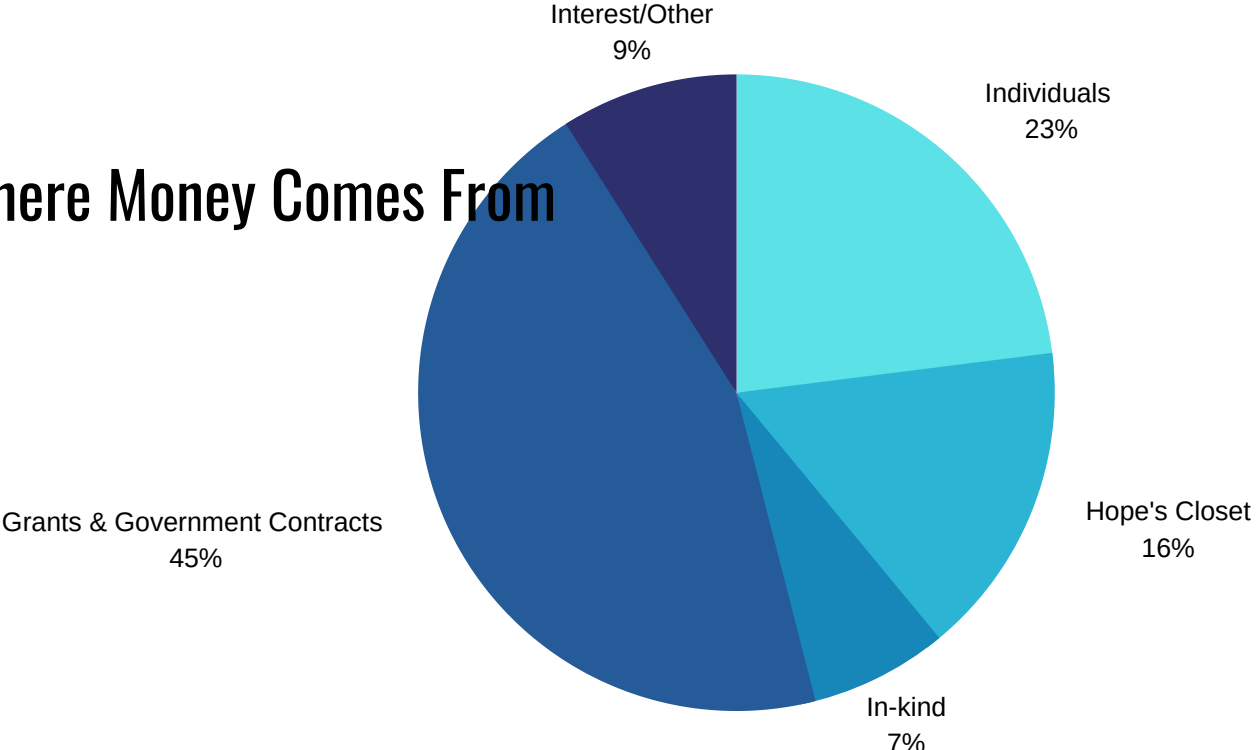

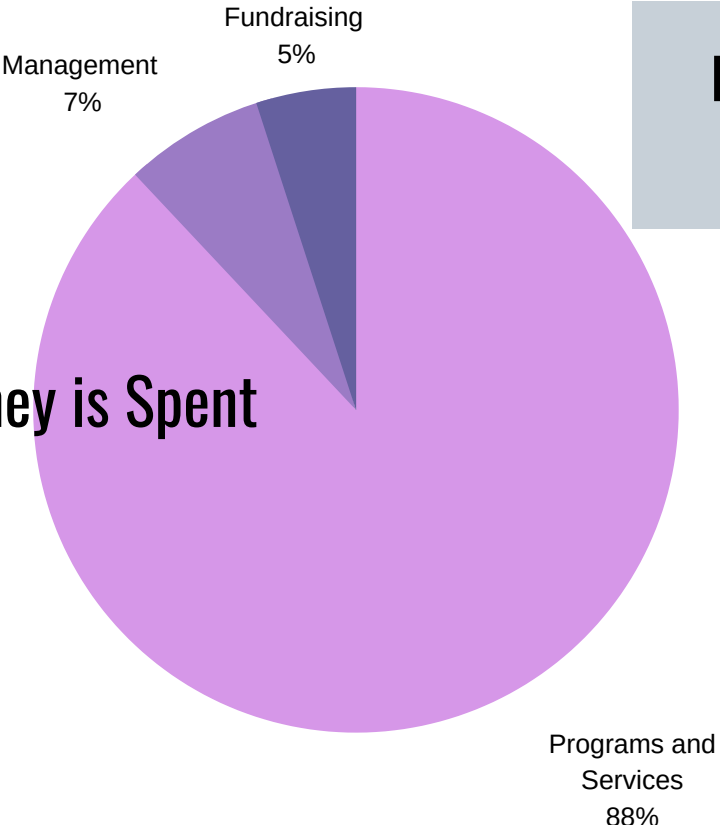
