- Ladies Underwear - Sizes 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, & 11
- Batteries - AA, AAA

## NON PERISHABLE FOOD NEEDS

Last year, New Life Center provided 27,849 meals for families in shelter. The following food items are needed on an ongoing basis and all items must be unopened, non perishable goods.

- Individually packaged snack items, such as granola bars, fruit snacks, and crackers.
- Individually packaged sweets, such as cupcakes and brownies.
- Individually packaged popcorn
- Dry pasta
- Rice
- Beans
- Canned Protein (tuna, chicken, Spam)
- Canned Stews and Chili
- Dry Cereal
- Peanut Butter
- Condiments (Ranch, Hot Sauce, BBQ Sauce, Ketchup)

All items listed here should be delivered to Hope's Closet located at 415 N. Litchfield Road Goodyear, AZ 85338. Deliveries are accepted Tuesday - Saturday from 10am to 1pm.

Please know that trained staff sort out items needed for New Life Center's emergency shelter. Also, every child and adult seeking refuge at New Life Center's emergency shelter has access to all the clothing and furnishing offered at Hope's Closet, completely free of charge.
